

# 7-12TH GRADE REPRESENTATIVES

## Duties and Responsibilities

---

- **Brainstorming**
  - Contribute ideas
  - Be supportive of others' ideas
  - Be attentive during brainstorming conversation
  
- **Event Planning and Implementing**
  - Contribute ideas for events
  - Communicate about events
    - Promote on social media
    - Personally invite other youth
    - Promote to other church members
  - Hold leadership roles for event
  - Assist with set-up and clean-up
  - Attend 50% of events held
  
- **Attending and Assisting with Weekly Youth Programming**
  - Attend one or more programs at least 3 times a month (*Collide, Sunday school, small groups, etc.*)
  - Brainstorm theme days/nights for weekly programs
  - Brainstorm games and activities for weekly programs
  - Brainstorm guest speakers or special topics for weekly programs
  - Occasionally lead classes and small groups
  - Occasionally lead bible studies
  - Occasionally lead and assist in games and activities
  - Occasionally give messages and personal testimonies
  - Communicate about weekly programming
    - Promote on social media
    - Personally invite other youth
    - Promote to other church members
  
- **Designing Youth Apparel and Accessories**
  - T-shirts and miscellaneous items like stickers, water bottles, hats, etc.

- **Leading Family Groups**

- Lead and support a group of students called “family group”
  - Create a communications hub for your family group (*Group text, GroupMe app, etc.*)
  - Check-in with family group members regularly
  - Support and encourage family group members
  - Be a buddy for members of your family group at events and programming
  - Help plug-in family group members to youth events and programming
  - Identify family group members for leadership roles in youth program

- **Representing Keller UMC Youth Program**

- Be an ambassador of youth program when new people visit
  - Make them feel welcome
  - Introduce them to other students
- Be an ambassador for the youth program at Keller UMC events and in the community
  - Speak on behalf of Youth Ministries Program
  - Volunteer at events on behalf of the Youth Ministries Program

- **Attending Youth Council Meetings**

- Council members are allowed to miss three meetings in a school year with a valid excuse
