## STAFF PARISH RELATIONS (SPR)

- This team is comprised of nine members, each with a three-year term.
- The <u>NEED</u>: Three persons willing to serve the term 2021-2023.
- The WHAT: This team integrates staff and congregational interests with some of the same functions as a personnel or Human Resource office.
- The WHO: Persons with interpersonal skills, the ability to keep conversations and information strictly confidential and who have the skills to evaluate current and future staff members.
- The WHEN: Typically, the team meets once a month, usually a Thursday evening, or as needed.

#### LAY LEADERSHIP

- This team is comprised of nine members, each with a three-year term, plus Revs. Estee and Jason Valendy as Co-Chairs.
- The <u>NEED</u>: Three persons willing to serve the term 2021-2023.
- The WHAT: This team prayerfully discerns and identifies for the congregation who God is calling into leadership positions within our church.
- The WHO: "People persons" with the ability to keep conversations confidential and are comfortable on the phone.
- The WHEN: Typically, the team meets every other month, usually Thursday nights.

#### **FINANCE**

- This team is comprised of church leaders as specified by the Book of Discipline plus congregation members determined locally to serve three-year terms.
- The <u>NEED</u>: Two persons willing to serve the term 2021-2023.
- The WHAT: This team works to raise, manage, and disburse the finances of KUMC so the mission of our church is accomplished through the discipline of stewardship.
- The WHO: Persons who are financially responsible, understand finance, are comfortable talking about money and dealing with numbers, and who can see the "big picture".
- The WHEN: Typically, the team meets once a month, usually Tuesday nights.

#### **TRUSTEES**

- This team is comprised of nine members, each with a three-year term.
- The <u>NEED</u>: Three persons willing to serve the term 2021-2023. (Of which two need to be female in order to be in compliance.)
- The WHAT: This team supervises and maintains all property, contracts, and equipment belonging to KUMC.
- The WHO: Persons who care about the physical property of the church, are knowledgeable about maintenance and upkeep, and who are good project managers.
- The WHEN: Typically, the team meets once a month, usually on Tuesday nights.

#### LAY MEMBERS TO ANNUAL CONFERENCE

- The <u>NEED</u>: Six voting members and two alternates.
- The WHAT: Delegates attend the Central Texas Annual Conference and vote on any actions proposed at this important event.
- The WHO: Open-minded persons willing to represent our congregation in any discussions and actions taken at annual conference.
- The WHEN: The next Central Texas Annual Conference is expected to be during the second week of June 2021.
